

**ST.ANDREW'S CHURCH, WICKHAMPTON
NORWICH NR13 3PB**



This is a medieval, grade I listed church, with a Norman chancel dating from around 1200 AD, and a nave circa 1300 AD. The tower and porch date from around 1450 but the sculpture of St. Andrew over the South door is more recent. The 3 stage tower has flint flush work panels at base with random flint work to upper stages, and it includes a stepped battlement with seated figures as pinnacles. The church includes Early English and Decorated styles. It was extensively restored in 1883.

St. Andrew's church is well worth visiting for its important WALL PAINTINGS from 14th century, very well preserved; and STONE SCULPTURE EFFIGIES from late 13th century.
