In reply to your Postagram 81G/1004/2/P2 dated 10th November, 1941, herewith report as requested on the above mentioned Officer.

2. This Officer has been on the Reserve of the Polish Air Force as Technical Officer since 1930. During that period he completed annual training periods of six weeks with the Air Force and during the last three x years of the period was working in an Aircraft Factory dealing entirely with airframes. Since arriving in this country he has been employed as follows:

No.52 O.T.U. Aston Down - Two to three weeks.

No.55 O.T.U. Usworth - Six Months.

No.61 O.T.U. Heston - Two Months.

No.58 O.T.U. Grangemouth .- One Month.

As far as can be ascertained he is now fully conversant with details of Spitfire Aircraft and Merlin Engines, and I have gone very carefully into his knowledge of these subjects before permitting him to lecture to the Polish pupils. I am perfectly satisfied that he is fully competent to give these lectures, and he is at the moment employed, apart from lecturing, in acting as liaison between the Polish pupils and the technical staff on this Station.
